

Volunteer Job Description

Title: Events Coordinator

Reports to: President, Board of Directors

Purpose of Position: Solicits and coordinates event volunteers to staff all adoption events (PACC911, Meet and Greets, etc.) using Sign Up Genius, oversees the annual picnic events by soliciting in-kind donations from businesses, prepares silent auction items and raffle baskets. Setup and tear down of events.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Participate in and coordinate all third party adoption events, and store meet & greet events.
- Coordinate with the Case Managers and Fosters to ensure foster dog attendance at events.
- Solicit donations from businesses for fundraising events
- Maintain and restock event box with supplies
- Recruit and orient fosters and volunteers at events
- Ensure that all events are fully staffed
- Fill in as needed at events including Set up and tear down of events
- Communicate using the rescues Signup Genius account.

Qualifications:

- Multi-tasking skills, basic computer skills, access to a large vehicle for supply transport
- Great organizational and communication skills
- Friendly and upbeat personality
- Knowledge of AZBTR Policies and Procedures on becoming a foster, adopting a dog and volunteering
- Demonstrated ability to comprehend software and systems use (e.g. Microsoft Office, Google Drive and RescueGroups.org) and follow AZBTR processes
- Physically able to lift up to 50 LBS

Training Requirements:

• Google Drive: Accessing forms and folders and saving files to the shared drive

- RescueGroups.org: Accessing lists of volunteers and fosters contact information as well as accessing what dogs are adoptable
- Training to learn AZBTR Policies and Procedures on becoming a foster, adopting a dog and volunteering

Time Commitment:

- 3-5 hours a week during event season (Oct-April)
- 4-5 hours every month for Meet and Greets across the valley
